UIL Eligibility Calendar 2014-2015

Date of Grade Check	Date Eligibility is Lost/Gained	Student Eligibility Status
October 3, 2014	October 10, 2014	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the first six-weeks grading period. Students not passing at the end of the first six-weeks grading period become ineligible.
October 24, 2014	October 31, 2014	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the three week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the first six-weeks grading period remain eligible.
November 7, 2014	November 14, 2014	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the second grading period. Students not passing at the end of the second grading period become ineligible.
December 5, 2014	December 12, 2014	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the three week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the second grading period remain eligible.
December 19, 2014	January 13, 2015	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the third grading period. Students not passing at the end of the third grading period become ineligible. (See holiday rule)
January 23, 2015	January 30, 2015	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the three week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the third grading period remain eligible.
February 20, 2015	February 27, 2015	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the fourth grading period. Students not passing at the end of the fourth grading period become ineligible.
March 20, 2015	March 27, 2015	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the three week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the fourth grading period remain eligible.
April 17, 2015	April 24, 2015	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the fifth grading period. Students not passing at the end of the fifth grading period become ineligible.
May 8, 2015	May 15, 2015	Ineligible students become eligible, if passing all classes at the end of the three week evaluation period. Students who were passing at the end of the fifth grading period remain eligible.
	First six-weeks eligibility	Eligibility for students during the first six-weeks - see page three of TEA-UIL Side-by-Side
	Grace period	All grading and evaluation periods are followed by a seven day grace period which ends at the end of the school day.
	Holiday rule	All students are eligible during a school holiday of full calendar week or more.
