

Steps to Access Your Child's STAAR Scores:

1. Go to www.texasassessments.com and you will see a screen like this:



2. If you have your access code, enter the code and your child's birthdate and click "log in to student portal" to view scores.
3. If you do NOT have your access code, click on "Find My Unique Student Access Code" link. You will then see a screen like this:

5. Enter your child's **first name only** and his or her **social security number (digits only - delete the dashes)** in the PEIMS ID field, and birthdate. Then click the blue "Go" button.
6. Your code will appear in the code field with a message saying, "Access Code Lookup Successful". Click the blue "Go" button again to see your child's scores.
7. You will first see your child's **overall performance**. Next, click on the **test name** and **click detailed results, test questions, and view your child's responses**.
